Prevention and Testing Team

Purpose of the Role

Within this role, you will have the opportunity to connect with people aged 16+ from Black and other minoritised communities in Hackney and City of London through:

- Outreach sessions and online engagement
- the development of sexual health and wellbeing awareness, workshops, training
- becoming a champion within your own communities through facilitating outreach sessions (both online and face-to-face, where appropriate)

You will report to the City & Hackney Sexual Health Coordinator, work with sessional workers and the Prevention and Testing Team to facilitate the delivery of resources, workshops and training sessions. The sessions will be delivered in a range of community settings that are frequented by marginalised communities.

We are a lived experienced organisation, and we value the knowledge, experience, and expertise of someone from the communities this project aims to support and empower.

Key Tasks and Activities

- Assisting in identifying and mapping out target populations, with a particular focus on Black African communities
- Actively promoting Positive East and working to recognise ways of engaging community members into relevant services
- Helping to educate around good sexual health, HIV, reproductive health and wellbeing
- Engaging community groups, businesses, charities, faith groups and other organisations who work with those at enhanced need in Hackney and City of London
- Helping people accessing information on HIV and sexual prevention (including LARC, emergency contraception, condoms and lube, PrEP, and PEP)
- Attending relevant workshops and training sessions
- Working within Positive East's policies and procedures

- Outreach Training
- Regular supervision

Hours and commitment

During the working week and outside "normal" office hours, including evenings and weekends.

Required commitment: Positive East expects a minimum monthly commitment of 7 hours, (usually 2 x 3 hour shifts, but this may vary) for a minimum of six (6) months once trained.

Once a session is scheduled and agreed to, attendance is mandatory unless for unavoidable reasons. **Unexcused absences without prior notice of 3 times will be grounds for dismissal as a volunteer.**

- Various locations across Hackney and City of London where target communities meet
